- How to start a dialogue?
  - With who (local, European, social scientists, ..)
  - What are reasons to get involved or not to participate (vision, urgency, technology/science, language, funding, legal)
- Framework
  - Which ways: Exchange Forum, workshops, ICT tools, ..
  - Identification of expectations and concerns
  - Setting rules of participation and commitment

- Long time process
- Change the name
- Stakeholders should be able to have influence on the programme if they participate
- Allow room for societal aspects in the research agenda (societal blind spots)
- But be honest & clearly define boundaries
- Interact with other platforms which have similar problems
